

Properly disposing of used oil and oil filters is critical to protecting the environment and is also becoming regulated throughout the country as landfills become over-crowded. Consider recycling your oil and oil filters, it will make a big impact on the environment. For example, recycling just 20% of all oil and oil filters used annually in the U.S. could reap big results, including:

- Nearly 400,000 cubic yards (over 300,000 cubic meters) of landfill space saved
- Millions of gallons of oil kept from being dumped into landfills
- More than 34,000 tons (over 30,000 metric tons) of filter scrap recycled to produce steel products
